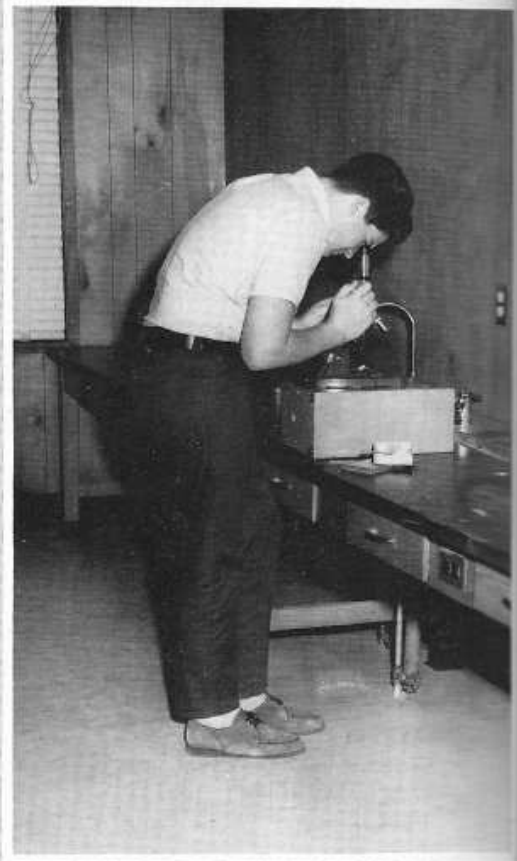

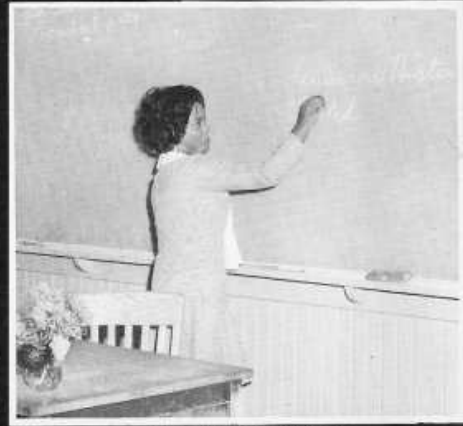

The Janitors, J. O. McKinnie and Leon Russell keep the campus grounds, classrooms, and buildings neat and clean as the days pass.

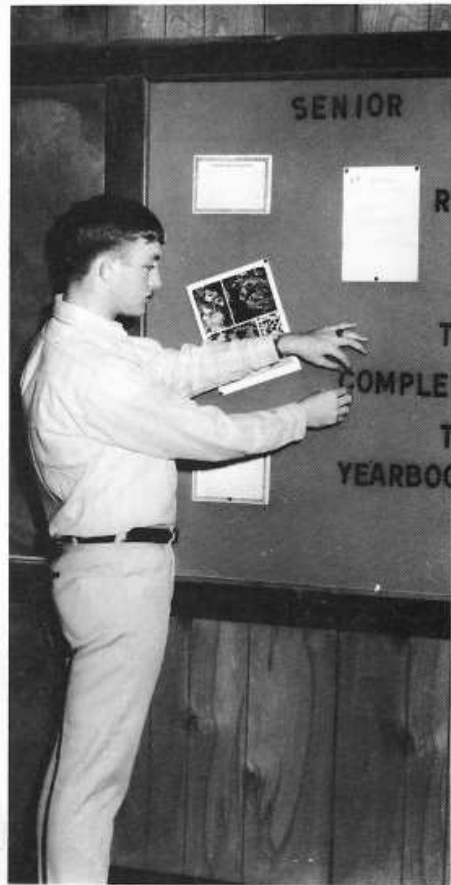
