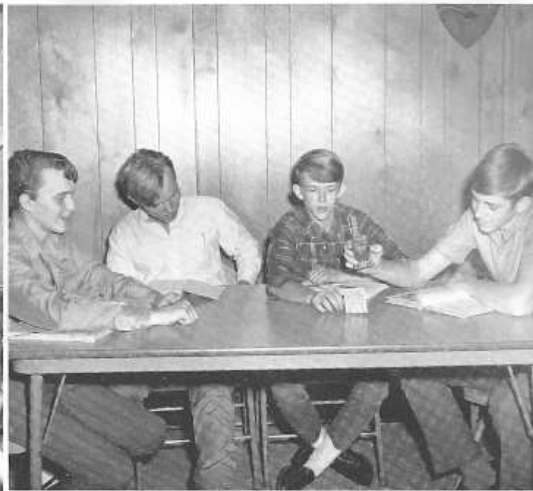

Retiring Faculty Members

This year concludes the teaching careers of five Linville High School faculty members. The total number of years devoted by these teachers to the education of others is 189 years. To these teachers go our best wishes for the future and our admiration for the past.



Among those retiring this year at Linville is Mrs. Corrie Parker.

After graduating from Louisiana Polytechnic Institute in the summer of 1940 as a home economics major with a B.S. degree, I began my teaching career at Linville High School as home economics teacher in September, 1940.

From 1940-1947 I taught home economics and eighth grade at Linville. The following year I taught the fifth and sixth grades at Spencer Grammar School. From 1948-1960 I again taught home economics at Linville. The following year I taught at Luling Elementary School in St. Charles Parish. And from 1961 to the present time I have been the home economics teacher at Linville. During this time I have also taught eighth grade science and ninth grade English.

During my teaching career I have taught under the following principals: Mr. V. L. Davis, Mr. Grady Holloway, Miss Alyce Schmitz, Mr. Garland Jones, Mr. Alton Hollis, and Mr. Billy Till.



Also retiring this year at Linville are the following teachers:



I, Mr. S. H. Cooper, am the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Sidney George Cooper. I was born in St. Gabriel, Louisiana. I attended Oak Grove High School in Acension Parish. I graduated from Louisiana State University with a major in Agriculture Education. Upon graduation from college I began teaching in September, 1929. I have taught at Olla and Jonesville, and for the past thirty-one years I have taught in Union Parish. I have devoted a total of forty-one years to the teaching profession.

I, Ida Lee McElroy Bright, am the daughter of Ellie and Malinda McElroy. I was born in Arkansas and attended Gardner High School in Strong, Ark. Later my parents moved to Marion. I received my college education at Grambling College. I began my teaching career in 1943 in Union Parish and have taught for 28 years.
